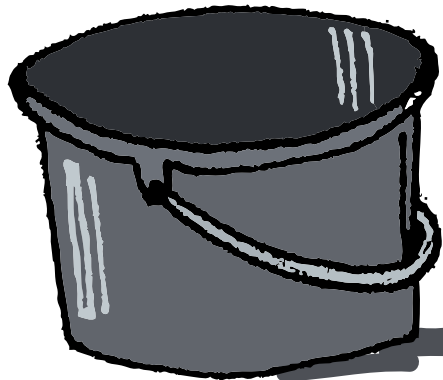

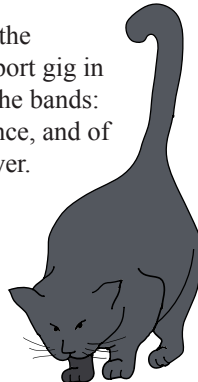
This is a huge project and the biggest problem of seeing it come through is the lack of human people made out of "the right stuff". Maybe there are some people interested in Holland?

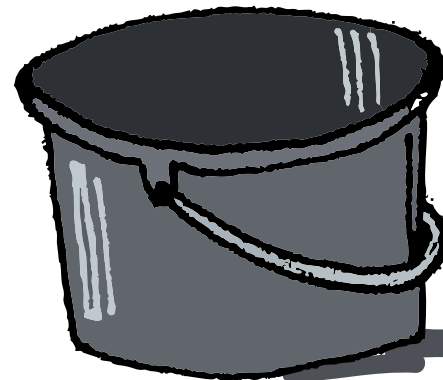
